Updates to Commission proposal for a Council Regulation fixing for 2024, 2025 and 2026 the fishing opportunities for certain fish stocks, applicable in Union waters and, for Union fishing vessels, in certain non-Union waters [COM(2024) 506]

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1. AMENDMENTS IN RELATION TO EU-NORWAY, EU-GREENLAND AND COASTAL STATES STOCKS

1. EXPLANATORY NOTE

Introduction

In October 2024, the EU participated in coastal States consultations on the management of Mackerel (*Scomber scombrus*), blue whiting (*Micromesistius poutassou*) and Atlanto-Scandian herring (*Clupea harengus*), which are stocks also managed by the North-East Atlantic Fisheries Commission (NEAFC)¹. The EU's positions in such multilateral consultations on fishing opportunities for those stocks for 2025 were based on positions endorsed by the Council on 10 October 2024. The outcome of those consultations was documented in Agreed Records for: (i) Atlanto-Scandian herring in the north-east Atlantic for 2025 signed on 18 October 2024²; (ii) for blue whiting in the north-east Atlantic for 2025 signed on 16 October 2024³; and (iii) for mackerel in the north-east Atlantic for 2025 signed on 22 October 2024⁴. The levels of the total catches for those stocks were set at 401 794 tonnes for Atlanto-Scandian herring, 576 958 tonnes for mackerel, and 1 447 054 tonnes for blue whiting. These levels are in line with the best available scientific advice, as published by the International Council for the Exploration of the Sea (ICES)⁵, which advised that total catches should be no more than 401 794 tonnes for Atlanto-Scandian herring, no more than 576 958 tonnes for mackerel, and no more than 1 447 054 tonnes for blue whiting.

At its 43rd annual meeting in 2024, NEAFC adopted recommendations on conservation and management measures for Atlanto-Scandian herring⁶, blue whiting⁷ and mackerel⁸ for 2025. Those

recommendations note the setting of fishing opportunities for Atlanto-Scandian herring, blue whiting and mackerel at the same levels that were agreed during the coastal States consultations.

It is therefore proposed to establish the fishing opportunities for Atlanto-Scandian herring, blue whiting and mackerel based on the levels of the total catches set out in the NEAFC recommendations for 2025 and in line with the approach⁹ applied since 2021 .

The EU also held bilateral annual consultations with Norway on seven jointly managed stocks in the Skagerrak area¹⁰ to agree on the management of those stocks, including the fishing opportunities for the next year. These consultations also focussed on the exchange of quotas and access arrangements.

The EU conducted these bilateral consultations with Norway based on the position endorsed by the Council on 4 October 2024.

The bilateral consultations were successfully concluded on 5 December 2024 and the outcome was documented in three Agreed Records¹¹. It is therefore proposed to set the relevant fishing opportunities at the levels agreed with Norway, and to implement the other provisions of the Agreed Records.

In accordance with the procedure provided for in the Sustainable Fisheries Partnership Agreement between the European Union, of the one part, and the Government of Greenland and the Government of Denmark, of the other part, and the initialled Protocol implementing that Agreement¹², the EU and Greenland agreed to establish the level of fishing opportunities available for the EU in Greenland waters for 2025 at the level agreed and provided in the initialled Protocol, to be confirmed by exchange of letters, as provided for in Article 12(8) of the Agreement, after the application, on a provisional basis, of the Protocol by both Parties.

It is therefore proposed that the relevant fishing opportunities be fixed at the level set out in the Protocol, taking into account the transfers to Norway agreed in bilateral fisheries consultations between the EU and Norway for 2025.

In bilateral consultations, the EU and Norway were unable to agree on access to their respective waters for two jointly managed pelagic stocks in the Northeast Atlantic: Atlanto-Scandian herring (*Clupea harengus*) and blue whiting (*Micromesistius poutassou*). The EU and Norway will resume discussions as early as possible with a view to finding suitable access arrangements. Pending the

conclusion of these consultations on the levels of access, those access levels should be marked as “to be established”.

The level of the fishing opportunities established for Northern shrimp (*Pandalus borealis*) in Greenland waters of ICES subareas 5 and 14 take into account a further reserve of 150 tonnes, which are to be used as currency in the event of potential purchase to Norway of additional shrimp quota in Norwegian waters of ICES subarea 4 in June 2025.

Regarding the fishing opportunities for mackerel in 3a; United Kingdom, Union waters of 2a, 3b, 3c; 3d and 4; Norwegian waters 2a and 4a (MAC/2A34-N), covering the areas of the TACs for mackerel in the North Sea (MAC/2A34) and Norwegian Waters (MAC/2A4A-N), it is proposed, in line with the Statement by the Council on the allocation of MAC/2A34-N¹³, to allocate fishing opportunities to MAC/2A34-N with a new relative stability key, from which 27,5% is transferred by Denmark to the holders of quotas in the TAC for mackerel in the Western Waters (MAC/2CX14-) based on the existing relative stability key for that TAC.

2. AMENDMENTS TO THE RECITALS IN RELATION TO EU-NORWAY, EU-GREENLAND AND COASTAL STATES STOCKS

Recital (27) is replaced by the following:

“(27) Mackerel (*Scomber scombrus*), blue whiting (*Micromesistius poutassou*) and Atlanto-Scandian herring (*Clupea harengus*) in the north-east Atlantic are subject to coastal States consultations on the fisheries management for those stocks, and are are stocks also managed by NEAFC. The Union participated in those consultations on the basis of the positions endorsed by the Council on 10 October 2024. The outcome of those consultations was documented in Agreed Records for (i) Atlanto-Scandian herring in the north-east Atlantic for 2025 signed on 18 October 2024¹⁴; (ii) for blue whiting in the north-east Atlantic for 2024 signed on 16 October 2024¹⁵; and (iii) for mackerel in the north-east Atlantic for 2024 also signed on 22 October 2024¹⁶. At its annual meeting in 2024, NEAFC adopted recommendations on conservation and management measures for Atlanto-Scandian herring¹⁷, blue whiting¹⁸, and mackerel¹⁹ for 2025. It is therefore appropriate to set the TACs for Atlanto-Scandian herring, blue whiting and mackerel in the north-east

Atlantic at the level of fishing opportunities agreed in the respective coastal States Agreed Records and NEAFC recommendations.

Recital 41 is replaced by the following:

“(41) The Union held bilateral consultations with Norway on seven shared and jointly managed stocks in the Skagerrak area (cod (*Gadus morhua*), haddock (*Melanogrammus aeglefinus*), herring (*Clupea harengus*), Northern shrimp (*Pandalus borealis*), plaice (*Pleuronectes platessa*), sprat (*Sprattus sprattus*) and whiting (*Merlangius merlangus*)), to agree on the management of these stocks and fishing opportunities for 2025, as well as exchange of quotas and access arrangements. These consultations were concluded on 5 December 2024 and the outcome was documented in three Agreed Records, signed by the Heads of Delegations on 5 December 2024. The relevant fishing opportunities should be set at the level agreed with Norway, and the other provisions of that Agreed Record should be implemented.”

The following recital (41a) is inserted:

“(41a) In bilateral consultations, the EU and Norway were unable to agree on access to their respective waters for two jointly managed pelagic stocks in the Northeast Atlantic: Atlanto-Scandian herring (*Clupea harengus*) and blue whiting (*Micromesistius poutassou*). The EU and Norway will resume discussions as early as possible with a view to finding suitable access arrangements. Pending the conclusion of these consultations on the levels of access, those access levels should be marked as “to be established”.”

Recital (42) is replaced by the following:

“(42) In accordance with the procedure provided for in the Sustainable Fisheries Partnership Agreement between the European Union, of the one part, and the Government of Greenland and the Government of Denmark, of the other part, and the initialled Protocol implementing that Agreement²⁰, the Parties agreed to establish the level of fishing opportunities available for the EU in Greenland waters for 2025 at the level agreed and provided in the initialled Protocol, to be confirmed by exchange of letters, as provided for in Article 12(8) of the Agreement, after the application, on a provisional basis, of the Protocol by both Parties. The relevant fishing opportunities should therefore be fixed at the level set out in the initialled Protocol, and taking into account the transfers to Norway agreed in bilateral fisheries consultations between the EU and Norway for 2025.”

1. EXPLANATORY NOTE

On 23 November 2024, the Commission services published the second non-paper updating the Commission proposal for a Council Regulation fixing the fishing opportunities for certain fish stocks, applicable in Union waters and, for Union fishing vessels, in certain non-Union waters ('the Commission proposal')²¹.

Due to an error in the calculation of the quota for cod (*Gadus morhua*) in the north-east Arctic, that non-paper included an erroneous EU quota. That figure should be corrected.
