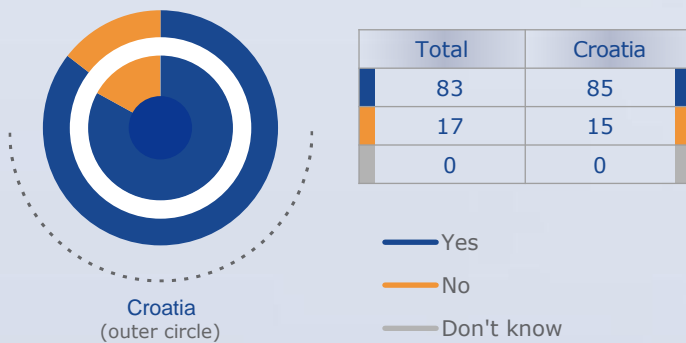

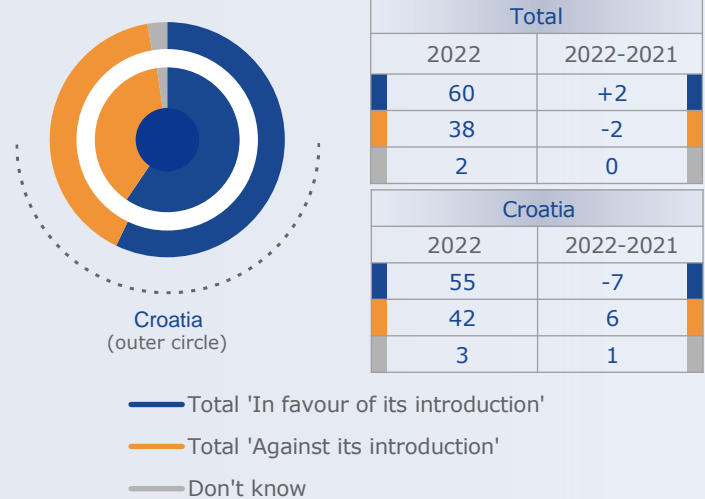

q1a Have you already used euro banknotes or coins? (%)

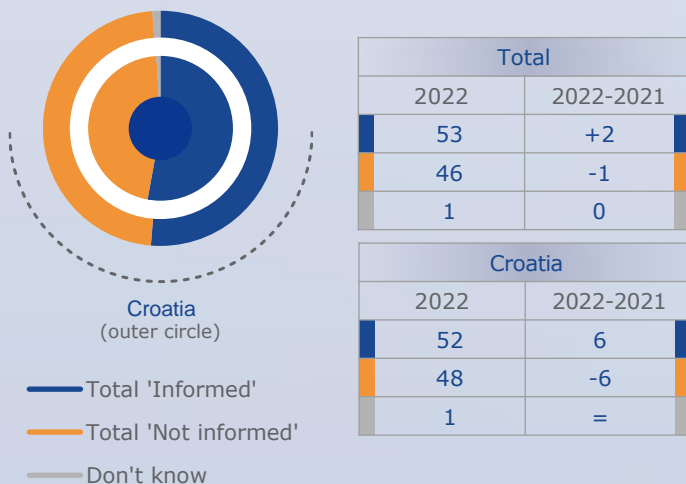

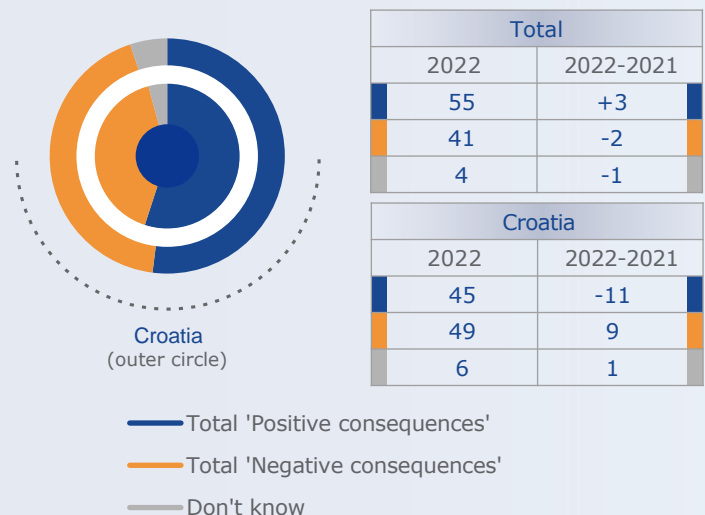
q11 Generally speaking, are you personally more in favour or against the idea of introducing the euro in Croatia? (%)

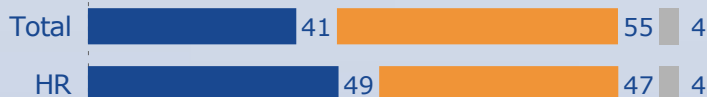

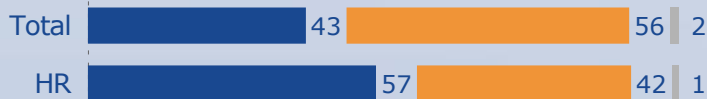
You are concerned about abusive price setting during the changeover

Adopting the euro will mean that Croatia will lose a part of its identity

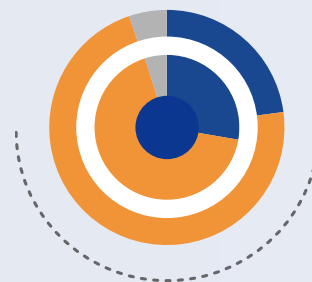

In your opinion, is Croatia ready to introduce the euro? (%)



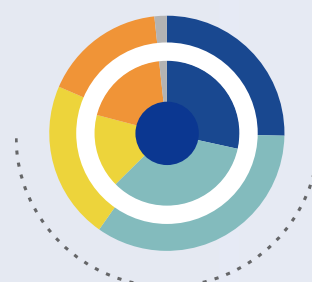
