Non-accessible content

Despite our best efforts to ensure accessibility of the ‘EU CODING’ website, we are aware of some limitations, which we are working to fix. Below is a description of known limitations and potential solutions. Please contact us if you encounter an issue not listed below.

Known limitations for the ‘EU CODING’ website:

- most pages have poor colour contrast
- some functionality is not accessible using only a keyboard.
- most heading elements are not used consistently.
- some/ labels are not correctly connected with their corresponding form fields.
- many buttons and/or links don’t have readable text.
- Most pages do not declare a document language.

- Some elements use ARIA attributes not according to their role or function.
