The notified body (NB) must enter any information into EUDAMED regarding certificates issued, including amendments and supplements thereto, and regarding suspended, reinstated, withdrawn or refused certificates and restrictions imposed on certificates. Such information will be accessible to the public.

# CERTIFICATE PAPER VERSION UNIQUE IDENTIFIER

The Certificate paper version is identified by a unique number which is the "NB number + Certificate number (+ possibly 'Revision number')".






**EUDAMED CERTIFICATE DATA VERSION IDENTIFICATION** 

The EUDAMED Certificate data version is identified by the "Certificate paper version unique identifier" and the "EUDAMED version number".





# **EUDAMED CERTIFICATE VERSION**

Versioning of the certificate data in EUDAMED

EUDAMED will keep track of the historical data provided for the certificate registration/updates and decisions on the status of certificates.

Therefore, EUDAMED will always create its own version

of the certificate data (incremental from 1 to n).
