Welcome!

Association 'Liepāja District Partnership' in cooperation with Latvian Fisheries Network invites you to the international conference 'Fisheries Areas Development Possibilities'.

The aim of the conference is to discuss and to exchange experience on promoting sustainable development of fisheries areas among fisheries local action groups (FLAG's), fisheries sector representatives, local governments and social partners.

The main issues for discussions will be as follows:

-  European Fisheries Fund Axis 4 contribution in development of fisheries areas – FLAG's local development strategies, benefits and challenges, good examples and possibilities for cooperation, etc.;
-  Development of coastal areas – challenges and possibilities in relation with fisheries sector development, tourism seasonality, infrastructure and employment;
-  Development of lake areas – inland fisheries development, as well diversification of local economy through development of recreational fishing.

Conference will be held in South-West Coast of Latvia near the Baltic Sea, hotel 'Jūrnieka Ligzda', Pērkone, Nica municipality (<http://www.jurniekaligzda.lv/welcome/>). We expect up to 100 guests.

Different communication methods will be used in the conference – interactive introduction, thematic presentations, work group discussions, as well evaluation, prioritization methods and study visit.

Conference languages: Latvian, English.

We will provide the possibility for conference participants to participate in the Latvian local coastal fishing traditions like fishing with sweep-net. During the study visit we will introduce with Pavilosta town (<http://www.pavilosta.lv/en>) which is the small harbor situated in the Baltic Sea Coast, having fisheries, tourism and sea sports recreation as the main economic activities. In Pāvilosta we will visit the projects, supported by the European Fisheries Fund.

How to get to the conference venue

Conference will be held in hotel 'Jūrnieka Ligzda'*** (Seaman's Nest), Pērkone, Nica municipality. It is situated in the South-West part of Latvia, located at 6th kilometer on the

road A11 Liepaja (Latvia) – Klaipeda (Lithuania) – see location at Google Map:

The closest international airport is Palanga Airport in Lithuania (56 km distance from the conference venue), it is small airport, but it serves flights from Copenhagen (Denmark), Oslo (Gardermoen, Norway), and Riga (Latvia). <http://www.palanga-airport.lt/en/>

Riga Airport is situated close to Latvia's capital city Riga; it is in 222km distance from the conference venue and it would take ~ 3 hours to come to the conference venue.
