



A 'COMMON PROVISIONS' REGULATION (CPR)



A common rulebook for the implementation of funds:

- More coherent
- Simpler to learn
- Simpler to combine





COMMON POLICY OBJECTIVES FOR UNION FUNDS

11 objectives simplified and consolidated to 5:

- 1. A smarter Europe (innovative & smart economic transformation)
- 2. A greener, low-carbon Europe (including energy transition, green and blue investments, the circular economy, climate adaptation and risk management)
- A more connected Europe (mobility and ICT connectivity)
- 4. A more social Europe (the European Pillar of Social Rights)
- 5. A Europe closer to citizens (sustainable development of urban, rural and coastal areas and local initiatives)

From 6 UP to 4 EMFF Priorities



OBJECTIVES

4 priorities:

- Fostering sustainable fisheries and the conservation of marine biological resources
- 2. Contributing to food security in the Union through competitive and sustainable aquaculture and markets
- 3. Enabling the growth of a sustainable blue economy and fostering prosperous coastal communities
- 4. Strenghtening international ocean governance and enabling safe, secure, clean and sustainably managed seas and oceans





A MORE FLEXIBLE EMFF ARCHITECTURE: NO MORE MEASURES

2014-2020

- Prescriptive measures (rigid description of eligibility rules in the Regulation)
- Straight jacket for Member States
- Many interpretation questions

2021-2027

- No predefined measures at EU level
- Broad 'areas of support' describing the scope of the fund
- List of ineligible and conditional operations (consistency with the CFP)
- Flexibility for Member States in the setting of eligibility rules





Novelties for CLLD

- No change as regards **composition** of local partnership (but no % for max. representation)
- Scope is extended to sustainable blue economy
- (F)LAGs must be selected AND **operational** within 12 months of OP approval
- Tasks of (F)LAGs better clarified
- Multifunding is possible with lead-fund option





NEXT STEPS

 Examination of COM proposals is on-going in Council and European Parliament

EP elections mid-2019

Realistic target date for approval end-2019 earliest





How to best prepare for the next period

- We need to speed up delivery in the current period
- We should aim for all EMFF UP4 funding to be committed by the end of 2021
- New FLAGs should be up and running 12 months after the adoption of the OP!
