<p>EMFF: Art. 60: "maximise the participation of fishery and aquaculture sectors in the sustainable development"</p> <p>CPR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- representatives of public and private local socio-economic interests- at decision-making neither public authorities nor any single interest group represents more than 49% of voting rights	<p>Draft EMFAF: no such provision</p> <p>Draft CPR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- representatives of public and private local socio-economic interests- no single interest group controls the decision-making

(F)LAG tasks

2014-2020

LAG tasks **shall include:**

- build capacity of local actors
- draw up selection procedure and criteria
- ensure projects' coherence with LDS
- prepare and publish calls
- receive applications
- select operations and fix amount of support
- monitor implementation and carry out evaluation

Exception: for cooperation projects selection could be done by the MA

(F)LAG tasks

2014-2020

CPR:

LAG tasks **shall include:**

- build capacity of local actors
- draw up selection procedure and criteria
- ensure projects' coherence with LDS
- prepare and publish calls
- receive applications
- select operations and fix amount of support
- monitor implementation and carry out evaluation

Exception: for cooperation projects selection could be done by the MA

2021-2027

Draft CPR:

LAGs shall **exclusively** carry out **all** of the following tasks:

- build capacity of local actors
- draw up selection procedure and criteria
- prepare and publish calls
- select operations and fix amount of support
- monitor implementation
- carry out evaluation

No exception for cooperation projects envisaged: so selected by the FLAGs

<p>CPR:</p> <p>(Art. 33) The first round of selection of strategies shall be completed within two years of the date of the approval of the Partnership Agreement. Member States may select additional community-led local development strategies after that date but no later than 31 December 2017.</p>

Member States may select additional community-led local development strategies after that date but no later than 31 December 2017.</p>	<p>Draft CPR:</p> <p>(Art. 26) MAs shall complete the first round of selection of strategies and ensure the local action groups selected can fulfil their tasks (...) within 12 months of the date of the approval of the relevant programme (or last programme concerned, in case of multi-funding)</p>

<p>CPR: 4 Funds under common rules (EAFRD, EMFF, ESF and ERDF)</p> <p>Need for coordination between ESI Funds</p> <p>Possibility of one Fund ("lead Fund") covering preparatory support and running and animation costs</p>	

Multi-funding

2014-2020	2021-2027
<p>CPR: 4 Funds under common rules (EAFRD, EMFF, ESF and ERDF)</p> <p>Need for coordination between ESI Funds</p> <p>Possibility of one Fund ("lead Fund") covering preparatory support and running and animation costs</p>	<p>Draft CPR: EAFRD no longer under common rules (but CLLD provisions apply), and significantly delayed (2 years transition period)</p> <p>ERDF, ESF+, EMFAF and JTF under common rules</p> <p>Multi-funding: mandatory joint Monitoring Committee and joint call One Fund to pay running and animation costs still possible A new meaning of "Lead Fund" – a common set of rules applicable to the whole strategy</p>

Please keep in mind the provisional character of the 2021-2027 legislation
