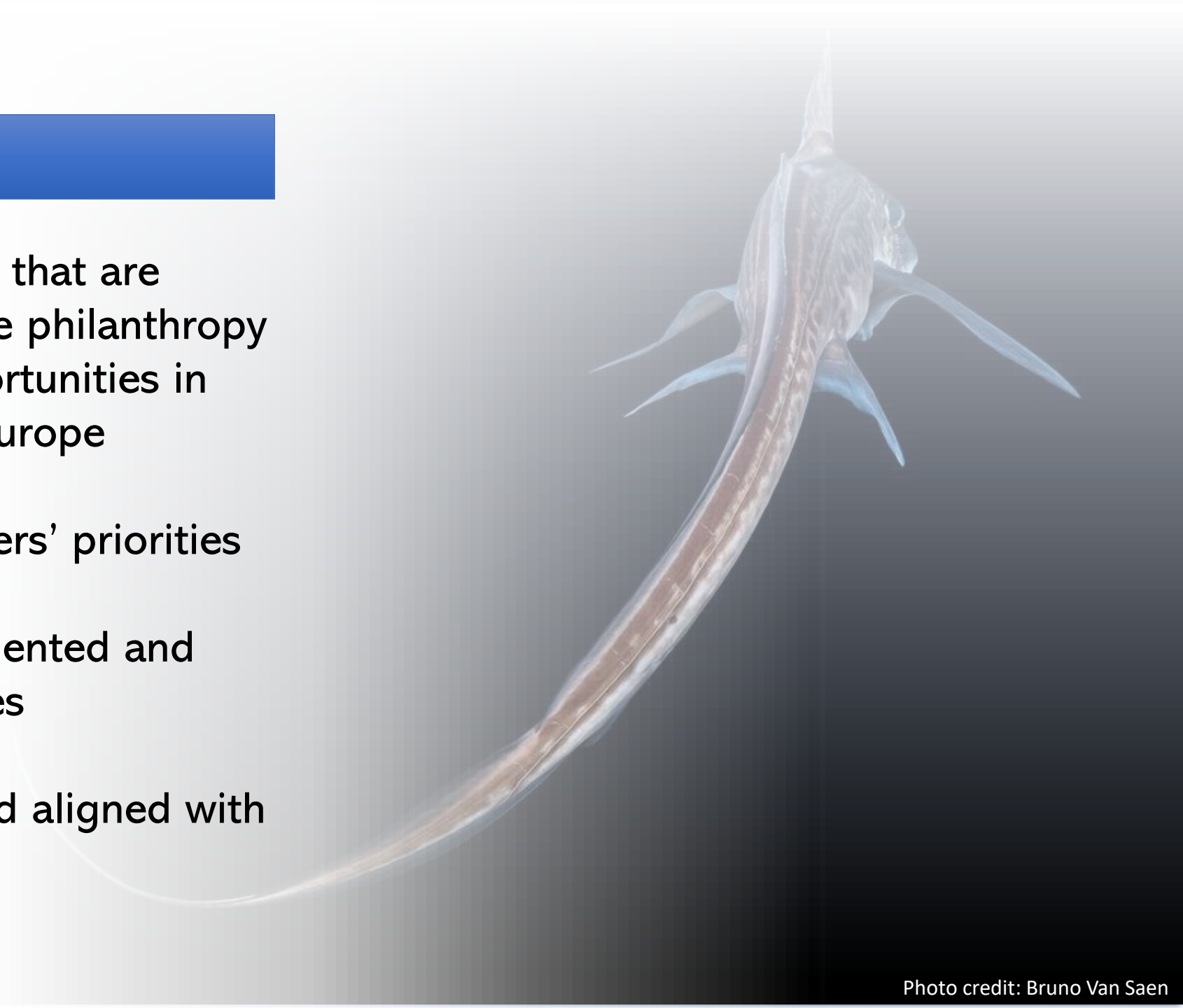
## Grantmaking

- Partners provide \$1 million annually; Members at least \$500,000.
- Granted over \$85,000,000 since 2011.
- Supported more than 70 projects involving more than 120 organizations in 50 countries.
- Focuses grantmaking on combating IUU fishing, establishing protected areas and stopping overfishing.



## Criteria

1. Focus on geographies that are underserved by marine philanthropy without ignoring opportunities in the United States or Europe
2. Aligned with our funders' priorities
3. Time-bound, policy oriented and opportunistic outcomes
4. Globally significant and aligned with Oceans 5 priorities





## Strategy

1. **Collaborative grantmaking** involves grantees with preference on national-level and indigenous-led NGOs resulting in unified and focused appeals to decisionmakers
2. Oceans 5 pursues **opportunities in countries with political feasibility**
3. Oceans 5 uses its **networks and field expertise** to review and prioritize



## Current Priorities

Overfishing and habitat loss are among the greatest threats to the world's oceans.

To address these Oceans 5 currently focuses its work in the following areas:

1. Inform fisheries management
2. Combat illegal, unreported, and unregulated (IUU) fishing
3. Establish and strengthen marine protected areas
