Community Led Local Development (CLLD)

 2014 – 2020 realization based on the integrated strategies.

Possible subsidies:

- 1. Integrated regional operational programme
- 2. Operational programme Environment
- 3. Operational programme Employment
- 4. Rural development programme



Principles of CLLD

 Focused on the rural areas, while involving Local Action Groups (LAG)

Conditions of use:

- LAGs are independent communities which integrate local citizens, NGOs, private business entities and public administration (municipalities, associations of municipalities, and public governance authorities).
- Only those LAGs will be involved in OP 2014-2020 implementation which will obtain certificate on compliance with standards issued by the Ministry of Agriculture of the Czech Republic.
- Strategy of Community Led Local Development (SCLLD)



Integrated regional operational programme (IROP)

- CLLD is implemented through an independent priority axis (PA 4)
- Allocation for CLLD is 390 mil. EUR (ERDF)
 - This equals 8,4% from total allocation of IROP (4,6 bil. EUR from ERDF).
- Co-financing 95% ERDF + 5% LAGs
- Assumption: all 180 LAGs will draw from IROP



Operational programme Environment (OP E)

- Financed from ERDF
- LAGs will be involved in OP E 2014 2020 in the frame of priority axis 4, specific objective 4.2. "To strengthen biodiversity" and specific objective 4.3 "To strengthen natural landscape functions".
- Prediction 53 LAG eligible (eligibility is based on MAS local specifics)
- Total allocation 18 mil. EUR (ERDF)



Operational programme Employment

Financed from ESF

Specific goal 2.3.1. - increase involvement of the local actors into the employment and social inclusion aspects, especially in rural areas.

- Allocation 57 mil. EUR (cca 2,7% of total allocation of ESF)
- Problems / challenges : social exclusion, lack of local governance involvement



Expected outcomes

- Decrease of local unemployment, support for local actors´ cooperation;
- Increase in employment rate of socially excluded groups;
- Better use of rural economical potential;
- Conditions for social entrepreneurs;
- Accessibility of social services and better life conditions for social excluded groups;
- Support for families;
- Decrease of excluded areas and their inhabitants.



Rural development programme

Financed from EAFRD.

Support for local development from LEADER initiative

- LAG co-ordinate the cooperation (based on the best knowledge of the territory)
- Complementary and co-ordinating role of LAGs
- Allocation 115 mil. EUR
