World Café methodology

World Café in 4 parallel groups, 90 min:

- → Working session based on the World Café method and the subsequent building of proposals.
- → 3 rounds of 20 min discussion leading to a list of 'smart' actions/initiatives to tackle global challenges at a territorial level.
- → In each room: 4 pre-defined global challenges on 4 tables
