Relevant Programmes for integrated local development 2014 - 2020



LEADER-CLLD-Multifond: 3 EU Programmes (EU and national funds)

- LEADER 26 Mio. Euro
- National ERDF 8 Mio. Euro
- ETC Italy-Austria ERDF 5 Mio. Euro

Additional Regional Programmes (regional public funds from Tyrolean Gov.)

- Volunteer Platform 2 Mio. Euro
- Climate Adaption 1 Mio. Euro
- Economic Development P. 19 Mio. Euro

Total: 61 Mio. Euro for 8 LAGs (approximately 2/3 from EU Programmes)



Encourage additional stakeholders in 2021- 2027

- ESF – calls in cooperation with LAGs regarding social innovation
- cooperation agreement for calls from the Climate and Energy fund (national programme) –using synergies with LAGs



Integrated approach in Tyrol



Platform of all relevant stakeholders on local level involved in programmes established for local level

One stop shop regarding management of all programmes => creating synergies

- avoiding double structures on local and regional level

Governance of policy makers

- our department secures Governance between regional and local stakeholders
- Innovation on local level leads to innovation at regional level – upscaling of good practices and project outcomes
- support from regional level to assist local initiatives - platform climate change

Governance of implementers

- Streamlining different initiatives, programmes and funds

CLLD-multifund approach (LEADER, national ERDF and ETC ERDF)

LEAD-Funds-Principle in Tyrol

- LEADER is the **LEAD-fund** and finances the management structure
- all funds contribute to the local development strategy
- on project level clear separation between the funds
- almost same eligibility rules and procedure for LEADER and national ERDF



Success factors of 2014 - 2020 will remain and new possibilities for simplifications will be used



Management Authority /Paying Agency

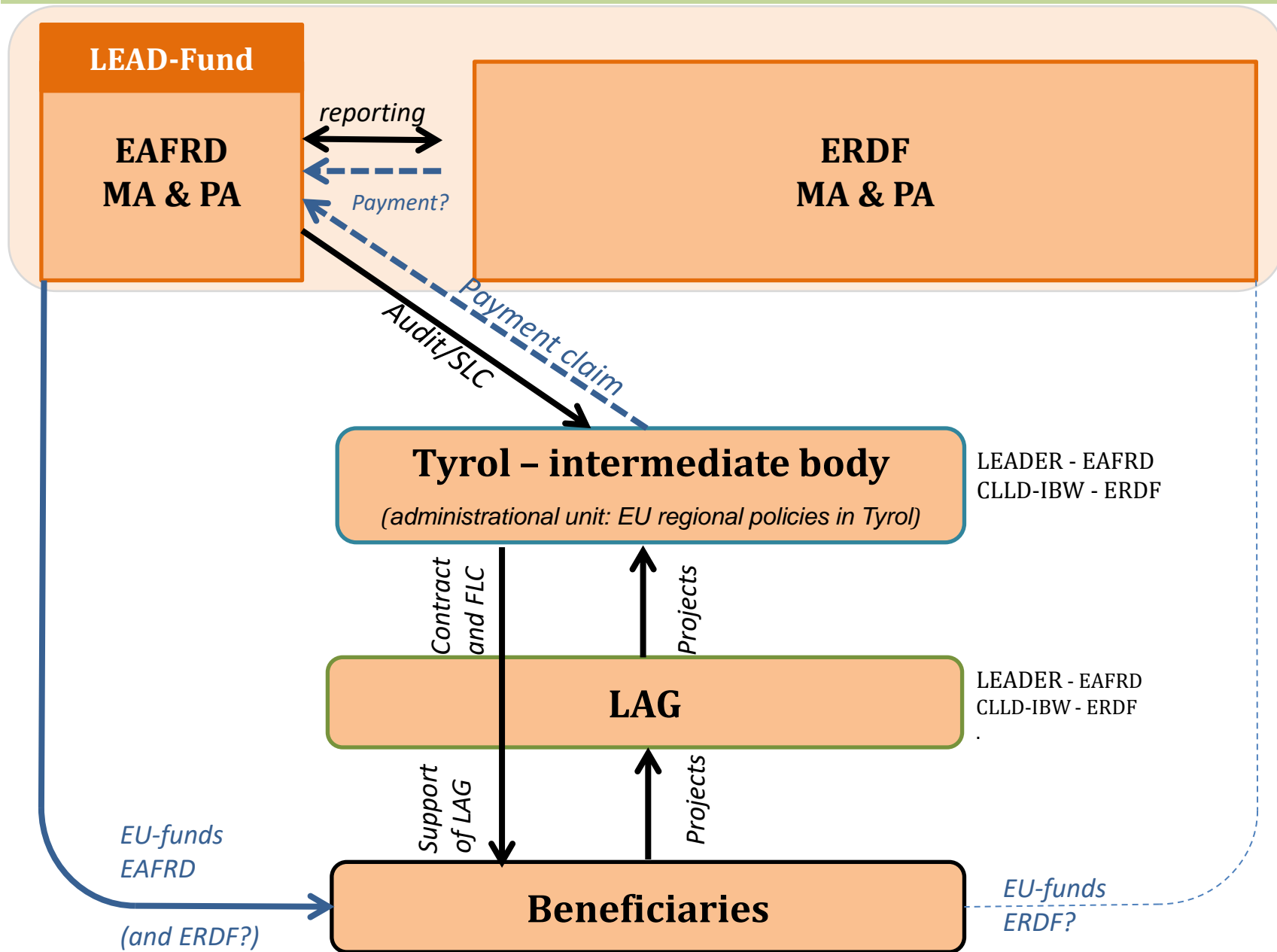
- **Audit-trail** through EAFRD also for national ERDF
- Reporting from MA/PA/IB on the basis of LEAD fund
- **central monitoring** system through EAFRD

main open tasks and questions:

- how to **organize transfer of data**, indicators and by whom efficiently (2 different monitoring systems)
- **different rules** between contributing fund and LEAD fund regarding reporting to EC
- detailed **financial flow** of contributing fund (via system of LEAD fund or ERDF system)
- implications due to the expected delay of 2 years in LEADER – n+2 or n+3 rule for ERDF-CLLD apply later?
