Project Transforming Mediterannean SSF

The project promotes stronger cooperation among fishers at the regional level, creating platforms for SSF fishers to unite and exchange ideas and encouraging the replication of comanagement schemes and sustainable fisheries practices across the Mediterranean.

By July 2022, at least 9 small-scale fisheries in four Mediterranean countries (Turkey, Croatia, Italy and Greece) have developed comanagement schemes leading to sustainable fisheries management.

By July 2022, **50% of** fisheries stakeholders (including cooperatives, fisheries delegates and associations) in Turkey, Croatia, Italy and Greece have developed the capacity to implement sustainable fisheries management.

By July 2022, stakeholders from at least **9 small-scale**. sustainably-managed fisheries in four Mediterranean countries and improved income and livelihoods

By July 2022, knowledge of the status of smallscale fisheries in the Mediterranean is significantly improved and dialogue and networking among fishers and stakeholders at the Mediterranean regional level is strengthened.
