MELTEMI in brief

The overall objective of the MELTEMI is to enhance the legal framework and **increase the capacity of public authorities, stakeholders and society at large on mitigating marine litter pollution.**

The project's outcome will be the elaboration of four **National Action Plan Proposals (NAPPs)** for the reduction of marine litter at source and a **Transnational Action Plan Proposal (TAPP)** among the 4 BalkanMed countries

creating a long term network for marine litter assessment and management beyond national (and project) boundaries

MELTEMI in brief

Along with the assessment of marine litter in beaches and sea, the project foresees and promotes the **active engagement of the society and the key-players** in a sequence of **Actions**, aiming at

- **informing,**
- **‘educating’**
- **training and**
- **networking**

all interested parties on a science and policy assessment framework of marine litter

at local, national and transnational level

The innovative part in MELTEMI is that the proposals for NAPPs and the TAPP, will be made by the key stakeholders and decision makers in each area/country and would be adopted at higher level.

The active participation of society, stakeholders and decision makers to the process will ensure this sustainability of results even after the end of the project and transferability to other areas.

Aims:

Assessment of marine litter on specific coastal zones

Review the existing national legal and policy frameworks and tools for their regulation/ management

Inform, Educate, Train & Engage society (Ocean literacy) in ML assessment and in best management practices (through ACTIONS)

Selection of best tools, policies and practices on ML management

Elaboration by the local stakeholders of the National Action Plans (through a series of workshops and training courses)

Elaboration of a common Transnational Action Plan Proposal (joint meeting of national stakeholders)

MELTEMI@School

Two schools per country will be informed via education seminars in marine litter reduction & actively involved in marine litter assessments.

Through MELTEMI@ School activities, students will participate in field trips in two beaches of each country.

Blue Cafes

During the project implementation, meetings with local people will take place at the leisure of a coffee shop, with the aim to inform and discuss marine litter issues. The main goal of the Blue Cafes is to encourage the local society to express its point of view about measures that should be taken against marine litter.

Information centres

Information centres will operate in each country where the citizens and visitors will have the opportunity to be informed about the MELTEMI project, their participation opportunities, and acquire promotional material.

National Stakeholders Training

A workshop and three training courses per country, will bring together the stakeholders and the scientists of MELTEMI, aiming at adapting the most suitable actions and tools against marine litter on a national level (NAPPs creation).



Transnational Cooperation

During a Transnational workshop the stakeholders of the four countries will get together and review the tools and actions against marine litter. The overall goal is the creation of a common and integrated Transnational Action Plan Proposal (TAPP) against marine litter pollution.







Activities such as school educational trips, communication campaigns, clean-ups, science campaigns, workshops, summer schools and exhibitions, deepen public understanding on the issue of marine litter and change perceptions and attitude towards waste. They aim to a turning point in a sustainable society, doing away with "throw away mindset".

This building of environmental consciousness of related target groups (citizens, tourism businesses, local authorities, students and educators of schools and universities, fishermen, port and ship workers, aquaculture operators, port authorities, journalists, environmental NGOs) contributes in the preservation of marine resources, raises awareness and engages target groups through practical interactive activities, such as "Adopt-a-beach", adapted to the needs and skills of the participants.

A unique way to engage the local community to improve the quality of their environment. Plastic fibers and harmful chemicals that are contained in cigarette butts affect the marine and coastal environment, especially during summer season where their numbers swarm. Action must be taken to reduce the presence of cigarette butts on the beaches and to inform and raise the awareness of beach goers, tourists and coastal tourism businesses on the ways to achieve that. This may be done through voluntary agreements among authorities and coastal tourism operators, which would include the certification of local businesses that implement good practices (e.g. voluntary smoking bans, provision of regularly emptied ashtrays in all public recreational areas). Initiatives to recycle cigarette butts should be further promoted.

It is a fact that aquaculture does produce litter and that the existing legal framework on ML from aquaculture is limited to animal-related organic waste. It is thus necessary to train aquaculture and maritime workers on preventing marine litter and to implement further environmental standards (e.g. EN ISO 14001:2015) for a more systematic collection and proper management of waste (reduction, reuse, recycle and appropriate discharge) and to increase their awareness on mitigating the issue of marine litter.

Plastic bags pose a significant threat to the marine environment. Local authorities, environmental and consumer organizations should encourage economic operators to voluntarily ban plastic bags and promote using alternatives, as a means to engage society into concrete actions to reduce waste generation and raise the awareness of their customers on the problem of marine litter.

Single-Use Plastics (SUPs) such as grocery bags, food packaging, bottles, straws, containers, cups and cutlery, stirrers and cotton buds threaten the marine environment. Targeted actions must be implemented their replacement with multiuse products. Local authorities and environmental education organizations, schools, universities, bars and cafes, hotels and retail shops need to be engaged into this practice. Specific award schemes should be developed for eco-friendly SUP-free hotels and tourist activities to promote this initiative.

Passive Fishing for Litter entails the collection of ML caught in nets by fishermen during their ordinary fishing activities and their return to shore for collection. The action leads to awareness raising among local fishermen (associations and industry) while their engagement promotes waste management practices optimization in the fisheries sector and facilitates ML removal and monitoring. An awarding scheme for the participating fishermen can be an incentive, to promote the action among them.



Following the NAPPs, a **Transnational Stakeholder Workshop (TSW)** will be organized in order to create a common, integrated, **Transnational Action Plan Proposal (TAPP)** against marine litter pollution for the four countries.




