- Master seaweed reproduction and farming techniques;
- Optimise reproduction periods to maximise yields.

The knowledge fostered could form the basis of a Good Practice Guide on seaweed farming by and for professionals.

Our overarching goal is to encourage seaweed farming in the area, to develop new harvest techniques and to add value to near-shore seaweed.
