ESKO – projects in general 2009-2013

- 56 FLAG funded projects
- Support 894.000 € altogether
- average 16.000 € per project
- Smallest 392€ (fisherman),
biggest 58.815€ (association)

ESKO – projects in general 2009-2013

- Municipalities participated in public funding with 160.000 € altogether
- This funding was used to the running costs of the FLAG outside project coordinators salaries which were funded by separate Activating projects
- estimated Regional economy input 5,5 million €

ESKO – business projects 2009-2013

- 27 pc of all projects (fishermen mostly)
 - share 48% of all projects
- 197.861€ of support
 - share 22% of support in total
- average support 7.300€ - varied from 392€ to 36.783€

RESULTS

Most results (quantitative) achieved in business projects (90%)

- 14 jobs created (objective 10) – 8 male, 6 female
- 24 maintained jobs (objective 100) – 19 male, 5 female
- 1 new business (objective 5) – male

RESULTS

- Promoting commercial fishing & fish farming was relatively successful (60% evaluated success or nearly reached goal)
- Promoting inter regional and transnational cooperation was relatively successful (61% evaluated success or nearly reached goal)
- Promoting fishing tourism was not that successful (46 % evaluated success or nearly reached goal)

RESULTS

According to the evaluation least successful ESKO was in

- Implemented youth initiated projects
- Increased activity and job possibilities for women
- Encouraging women into the fisheries

SUGGESTIONS BY TK-EVAL (evaluator)

In future more focus should be on

- Evaluating and monitoring the outputs of projects versus strategy objectives
- Involving young people in project activities
- Promoting Fishing tourism
