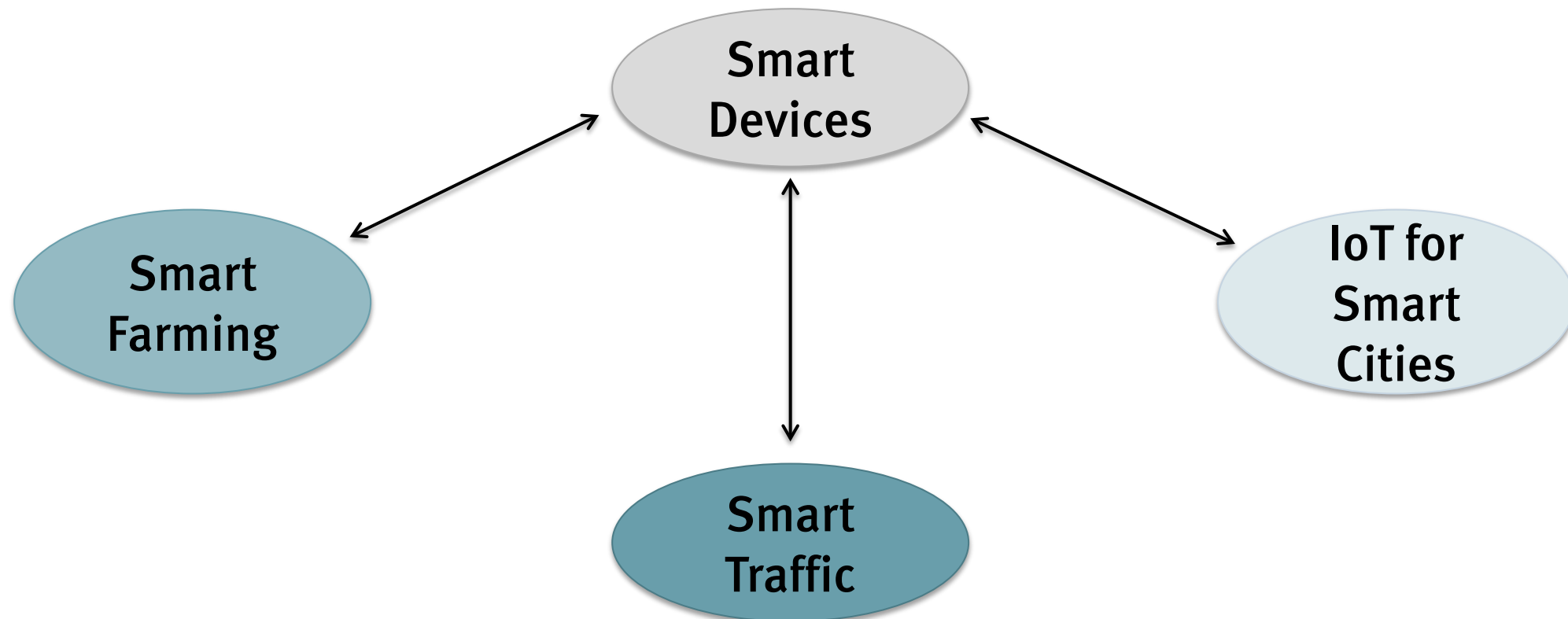

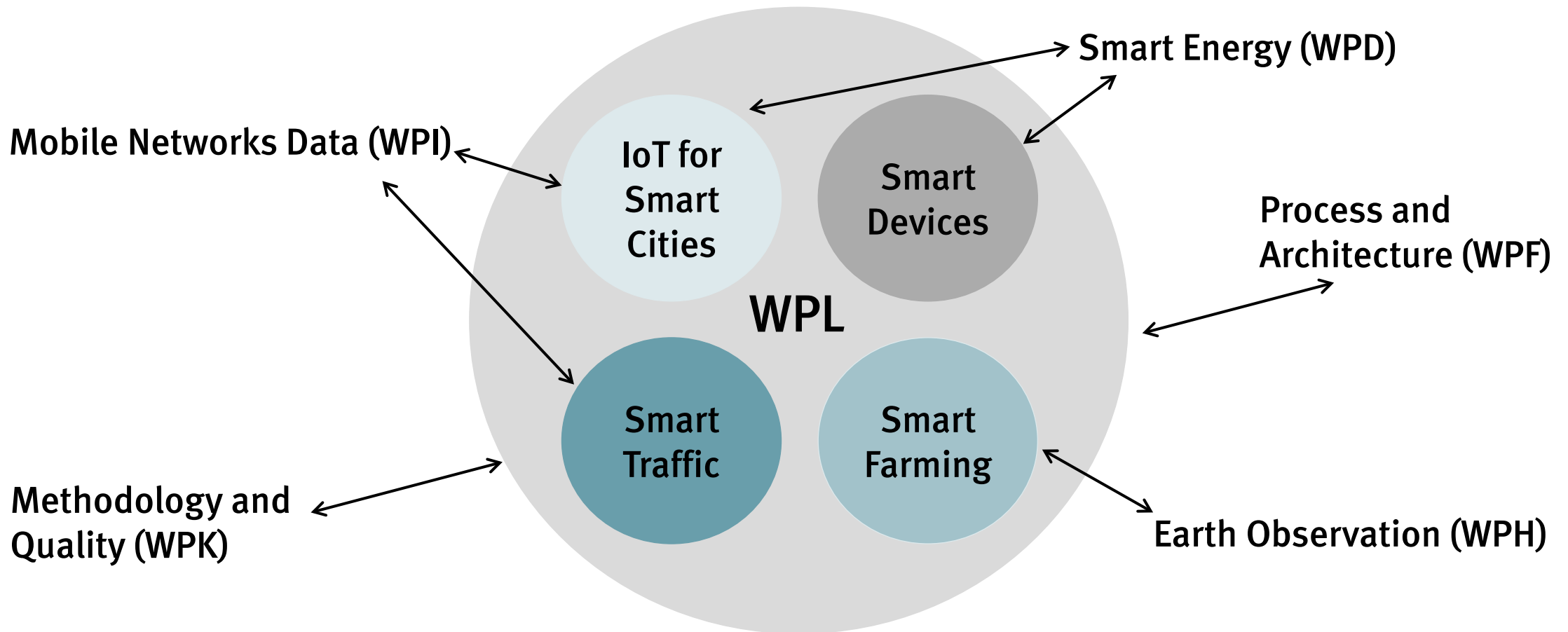

Evaluation remark of Eurostat

“It is not clear for which use cases a proof-of-concept for producing smart statistics will be realised (objectives and the description of work).

Moreover, the demonstration of the capabilities to produce statistics through the possible production of experimental statistics should be mentioned in the description of work.”

Terms

- » **Proof-of-concept**
 - » is a realization of a certain method or idea in order to demonstrate its feasibility, or a demonstration in principle with the aim of verifying that some concept or theory has practical potential. A proof of concept is usually small and may or may not be complete (see Wikipedia).
- » **Feasibility study**
 - » is an assessment of the practicality of a proposed project or system (see Wikipedia).
- » **Experimental statistics**
- » **Tasks**
 - » 2: Case studies
 - » 3: Use cases
 - » 4: Subtasks

Proposal

Task 1: “The aim of this task is (...) to prepare proof-of-concepts”

Task 2: Conduct of different case studies

- » In case study 3 (FR) "it is planned to initiate a pilot project (...) which could act as Proof of Concept"

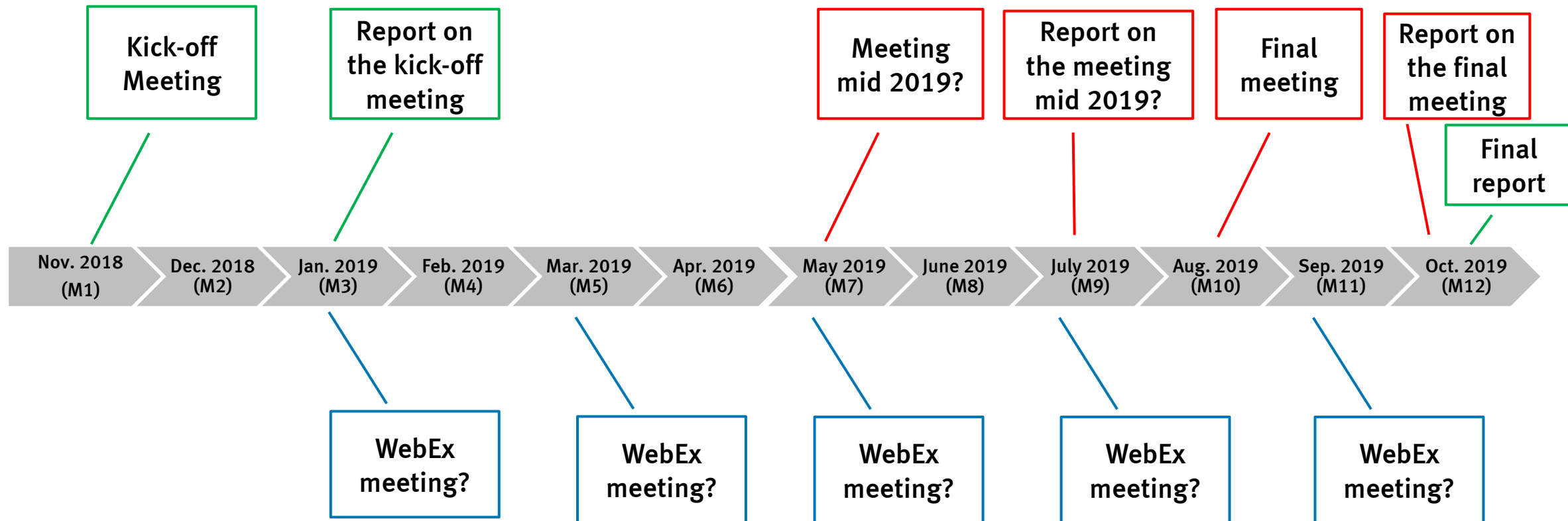
Task 3: Conduct of “a first study”

- » “two use cases will be examined in more depth”

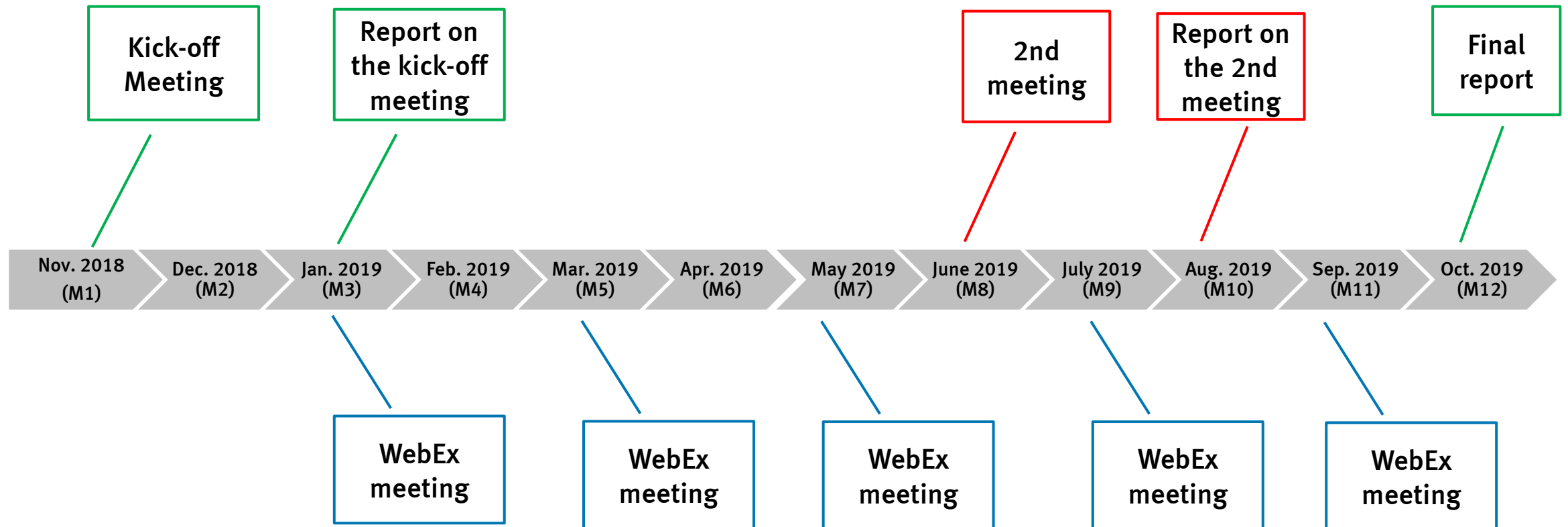
Task 4: Examination of two data sources
