

The **International Day Against Homophobia, Biphobia and Transphobia** (or [IDAHOBIT](#)) is celebrated 17 May since 2004 to commemorate the day that homosexuality was removed from the International Classification of Diseases of the World Health Organization (WHO) in 1990.<sup>[1]</sup>

It is coordinated by the Paris-based "IDAHOBIT Committee", founded and presided over by French academic Louis-Georges Tin. The day aims to coordinate international events that raise awareness of [LGBT](#) rights violations and stimulate interest in LGBT rights work.
