- Two types of Partner searches: offers of expertise to other organisations and requests for expertise from other organisations.

- The Topic pages include a section where the organisations which are looking for partners to participate are listed.


- You can easily publish a new expertise offer/request for any of your organisations from the topic page.

- When looking for partners, you can contact the organisation replying to their expertise request /offer via an action button.

- When viewing a profile for which you have access to maintain the organisation profile, you will have action buttons which allow you to easily manage your expertise offers/requests.

- The organisation profiles include now a section at the bottom where all the active expertise offers /requests of the organisation can be viewed at once.
