### **STRUCTURE OF THE ACFA [1]**

**The Working Groups meet according to the schedule of meetings [2] proposed by the Secretariat and adopted by the Plenary.**

**WORKING GROUP 1:** Access to fisheries resources and management of fishing activity. CHAIRMAN: J. GARAT (EUROPECHE); VICE-CHAIRMAN: G. BUONFIGLIO (COGECA)

**WORKING GROUP 2:** Aquaculture, shellfish and molluscs.  
CHAIRMAN: G. BREST (EMPA/AEPM); VICE-CHAIRMAN: J. OJEDA (FEAP)

**WORKING GROUP 3:** Markets and trade policy  
CHAIRMAN: M. KELLER (AIPCE); VICE-CHAIRMAN: S. O'DONOGHUE (EAPO)

**WORKING GROUP 4:** General questions: economics and sectoral analysis  
CHAIRMAN: J.M. GONZALEZ GIL DE BERNABE (EUROPECHE); VICE-CHAIRMAN: J.A. MOZOS (CEP)

**The BUREAU** allocates the subjects covered by the annual work programme between the working groups. It makes sure that the work of the groups is progressing and prepares the opinions of the Plenary. It is composed by the Chairmen and Vice-chairmen of the working groups and the workers representative from the Social and Sectoral Dialogue Committee. The functions of Chairman and Vice-chairman of the Working Groups are allocated to specific organisations as a function of the type of work each does.

**The PLENARY** decides on the annual work programme of the Committee and expresses the committee's opinions. It is composed by 21 representatives of the professional organisations representing the producer companies, the processing industry and traders in fishery and aquaculture products and non-professional organisations representing the interests of consumers, the environment and development.
