The conference is going to assess users' satisfaction in this domain as well as needs for future services development. The target audience and participants, as specified below, will include service providers, transport operators and various stakeholders (e.g. Coast Guards, Ministries of Transport, REMPEC).

The Conference will be organized in a way that will allow not only oral presentations but, most importantly, participated and lively discussions on the proposed topics. Services, user experiences and needs will be presented, and roundtables and discussion with all participants will be structured, with the main objective of drafting, by the end of the conference, a vision document about safer transport in the Mediterranean Sea.

The event is organized in the framework of the project IONIO (IONian Integrated Marine Observatory), funded by the European Territorial Cooperation Operational Programme "Greece-Italy". This project, involving involves three different institutes (CMCC, ENEA and HCMR), is aimed at providing environmental information about the Southern Adriatic and Northern Ionian Area, to support safer maritime traffic and the reduction of pollution hazard. IONIO provides an observing system with in situ weather-oceanographic measurements in real time from moored buoys, ships of opportunity and Argo floats; a forecasting system delivering in real time high resolution currents and wave products; an information system based on Web tools for the rapid exploration of the environmental information from the regional stakeholders; and three innovative Decision Support Systems (DSSs), for pollution hazard mapping, ship routing and safety, and search and rescue. IONIO products and services are going to contribute to the future cross border marine water management and safety.

Therefore, the main services that will be discussed during the conference are: provision of weather-oceanographic forecast for sea situational awareness; ship routing; oil spill prediction; and search and rescue."
