

→ The user can download shapefiles, load Web Services etc. via the national pages



Land cover data
(LPIS) – thematic
maps

DG AGRI started **re-using** data from LPIS quality assessment process for **analytical purposes** and creation of '**thematic maps**' for portal

LIPS **population data**: Coordinates of centre of reference parcels as well as area under arable land, permanent crops, permanent grassland

Aggregation at regional level. No publication of individual data.

Example for **Bayern**, Germany (2017-2020)










Analysis of LPIS spatial data in Bayern, Germany (2017-2020)


- ✓ Reference of the points to the territorial level (NUTS III)

Land Cover in Bayern as Time series
















Analysis of LPIS spatial data in Bayern, Germany (2017-2020)


- ✓ Reference of the points to the local administrative units (LAUs)

Art. 65 (HZR)

IACS data sharing and keeping

(...)

- **3.** Member States shall ensure that data sets collected through the integrated system which are relevant for the purposes of **Directive 2007/2/EC** of the European Parliament and of the Council71 or relevant for monitoring Union policies, are shared free of charge between its public authorities and made publicly available at national level. Member States shall also provide the institutions and bodies of the Union with access to these data sets.
- **4.** Member States shall ensure that data sets collected through the integrated system, and which are relevant for the production of **European statistics** as referred to in Regulation (EC) No 223/200972, are shared free of charge with the Community statistical authority, the national statistical institutes and, where necessary, with other national authorities responsible for the production of European statistics

Legislation update

INSPIRE revision

Directive 2007/2/EC – mandatory by 1 Jan 2022

Interviews with EU institutions and 7 Member States (Belgium, Bulgaria, Germany, Spain, Ireland, Italy and Lithuania) took place in April/May 2021

Targeted surveys targeting specific communities or sectors (environmental community, spatial data community, marine community, agriculture community, private users) took place in May 2021.

The **public consultation** ran until 12 July 2021, a summary is available on the European Commission's 'Have your Say' page. **Preliminary findings:** The Directive is still relevant. Progress on implementation was made, but still no full implementation. Need for streamlining with new and emerging European data legislation (+

technology progress). There is a scope for simplification and making the provisions more technically neutral.

Adoption and publication of the evaluation Staff Working Document - January/February 2022 –

Deliverables will be published on the INSPIRE knowledge base (https://inspire.ec.europe.eu)

Impact assessment – finalised and successfully passing through the internal regulatory scrutiny board – December 2020

Inter-service consultation ISC) – under preparation

Online **public consultation** – will follow the ISC

Proposal of the **list of HVDs** could be submitted to the Open Data Committee in **Q4 2021**

- -Better discoverability (EU geoportal adapted, TG about metadata for LPIS and GSAA)

- -Progress in Soil health (erosion and pesticides) important topics vs Green Deal and CAP env. performance
- -IACS data exploration and integration : huge potential... start discussion for practical setup of *an* integrated system on land resources?
