



SESAM Release 9.1

Release Notes

Release 9.1 of SESAM is a minor software release containing new features and bug fixes.

1. NEW FUNCTIONALITIES

The purpose of this release is to prepare SESAM for the forthcoming Single Submission / Rejection implementation and to introduce changes to the publication and dissemination activities pages. A new Scientific Report was implemented for ERCEA.

1.1.1. All project funding schemes

- The Publication page was modified in order to include all sort of publications in addition to the peer-reviewed journals.
- In the Publications page, the maximum length of the 'Title of the periodical or the series' input field was modified in order to accept 200 characters.
- The review report layout was slightly modified in order to improve the readability.

1.1.2. Marie Curie funding schemes

- The IRSES Periodic Report was fixed in order to allow the deletion of a selected row in the secondment table.

1.1.3. ERC funding schemes

- A new Scientific Report was implemented for ERCEA.
- A 'Print Draft' button allowing to print a draft was implemented in all reports.

2. BUG FIXES / CORRECTIONS

The following bug fixes or modifications were implemented:

- The ordering function in the Publications page was fixed and is now working as expected.
- A bug specific to Researchers Registration Reports showing a 'validate' button in place of a 'submission' in Internet Explorer 8 was fixed.
- The popup warning for Internet Explorer compatibility mode was restored.
- The popup for auto-save does not show up anymore when the user clicks on the browser back button.
- The IRSES Periodic Report was fixed in order to properly display the amount of EU contribution in secondment tables.
- Declaration of conformity for CIG and IRSES were configured to be registered by the EC mail archiving system.

- SESAM was modified to prepare Single Submission / Rejection implementation.
